<i>Approximate PGY-4 Salary</i>	\$76,833.96. Based on salaries for academic year 2021-2022.
<i>Moving Assistance</i>	Up to \$5,000. In compliance with federal regulation, this is taxable income.
<i>Leave</i>	Fellows are granted an annual bank of 25 days of leave . Up to 7 days of leave may be designated for use on official Providence holidays.
<i>Holidays</i>	Seven paid holidays per academic year.
<i>Bereavement Leave</i>	Up to 24 hours of bereavement leave.
<i>CME Time</i>	Five working days per 12-months of fellowship.
<i>CME Reimbursement</i>	\$2700 to be used over 12-month fellowship.
<i>Certifications</i>	Registrations provided for BLS (renewal only), ACLS (renewal only), NRP, PALS, ATLS, ALSO
<i>Professional Memberships</i>	Memberships provided to the Alaska State Medical Association and the American Society of Addiction Medicine.
<i>Computer Access</i>	Remote access to email, hospital and clinic records and electronic resources.
<i>Library and Electronic Resources</i>	Electronic access to more than 2,300 eJournals and 1,200 eBooks through the University of Washington.
<i>Malpractice Insurance</i>	Provided, including "tail" insurance.
<i>Medical, Vision, Dental, Life, Disability Insurance, Retirement</i>	Refer to Benefits At- A-Glance Alaska.
<i>Moonlighting</i>	Opportunities available throughout Alaska for fellows in good standing.
<i>Recreation</i>	Fully equipped in-house exercise gym.
<i>Rural Rotations</i>	Costs for rural travel and housing at rural sites will be provided.
<i>Miscellaneous</i>	Parking at hospital and clinic provided.
